SCLL 2020 Local Rules Summary

Time Limit: No inning shall start after two hours (Majors-AAA) or 1 hour 45 minutes (AA-A) have elapsed from the start of the game. New innings start when the last out is made in the bottom of the previous inning.

Exception: Majors division games played during the weekday will not have an imposed time limit.

League Age	Pitches Per Day
13-16	95 pitches
11-12	85 pitches
9-10	75 pitches
7-8	50 pitches

The manager must remove the pitcher when said pitcher reaches the limit for his/her age group as noted below, but the pitcher may complete current batter and may remain in the game at another position.

Pitcher's Rest Requirements – League Age 14 and Under
Pitcher must have at least four calendar days of rest before pitching again.
Pitcher must have at least three calendar days of rest before pitching again.
Pitcher must have at least two calendar days of rest before pitching again.
Pitcher must have at least one calendar day of rest before pitching again.
No calendar day of rest is required before pitching again.
